CAO Corner

May brings about not only flowers but the Province of Alberta's "relaunch" strategy to opening and lifting some restrictions that were put in place by COVID-19. With the kick off May 2nd for golf courses to open up with no access to clubhouse or pro shops. Hardisty Lakeview Golf Course will be up and running for our avid golfers to stretch out their golf swings. The Alberta Government's staged approach is to move cautiously into the lifting of restrictions. Moving forward with care and common sense will save us much time and the possibility of having to do another "shutdown".

May is also the kick off to many of our Industrial Stakeholders projects. Preparation for new service tie in for the Gibson Primary Control Center will take place mid May along with the site prep and grading. TC Energy's prime contractor, WorleyCord, for the first phase of the Keystone XL project, will be mobilizing to commence construction on facility work and pump stations. While other projects like Enbridge's salt cavern upgrade, along with the Husky & Gibson interconnects & Husky's (3) new tank construction to add 1.5 million more barrels of oil storage to their facility will bring a phased in approach of around 600+ workers through out the spring & summer to the Hardisty area.

I would like to welcome our "summer power team" of public works personnel who will be onboard starting May 4th and in June. Bryan Kobzey our summer public works operator will be joining us to gain his water and wastewater hours for his NAIT Water and Wastewater Level I Operator's certification.
