

**Title: Hardisty Fire - Rescue Dept.  
Training**

**Policy Statement:** The Council of the Town of Hardisty recognizes that training is important to enable fire fighters to maintain and upgrade their skills to provide the level of service required by the Town.

**General:**

1. Regular training sessions are held at the Fire Hall on a weekly basis unless specifically advised otherwise.
2. Every member must make a committed effort to attend as many practices as possible.
3. A schedule of topics to be covered at training sessions shall be posted in the Fire Hall.
4. In addition to basic fire training, the Department may develop additional specialized courses (i.e. haz-mat, vehicle rescue, ice rescue etc.) and may take place on weekends or other evenings.
5. Any active member may be sponsored by the Department to attend fire etc courses in the region or in Vermilion.
6. Within one year of being accepted as a member, the fire fighter will be trained under S100 (or equivalency), S200 and S300 of the fire etc 1001 fire fighter training standard.
