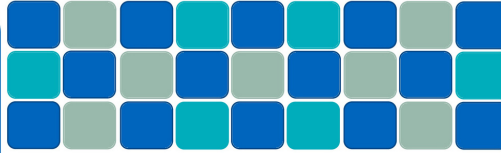
Bin Services Customers: Please be aware, because of the holidays, Bin Service Dates may be altered.
