## LET'S UPDATE OUR HOUSE NUMBERS!

A request from our fire department and our EMS to all residents in Hardisty to update the numbers on your houses in a visible manner.

This includes the houses at the lake, please put your house numbers in a visible location on your house to clearly identify it.

As per bylaw 1165-11 Civic Addressing Bylaw

The Address Number required to be displayed pursuant to this Bylaw shall be on the contrasting background. The minimum size of the characters shall be as follows:



Distance Building Setback from Curb	Minimum Character Size
0 – 15 meters (0 – 49.2 feet)	10 cm (4 inches)
15 – 20 meters (49.2 – 65.6 feet)	15 cm (6 inches)
Greater than 20 meters (65.6 feet)	20 cm (8 inches)

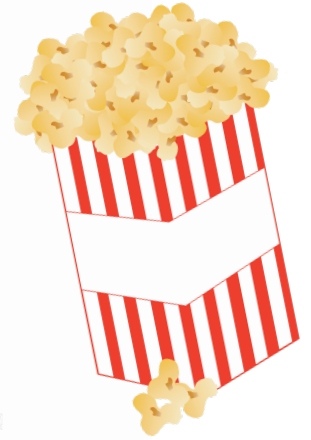
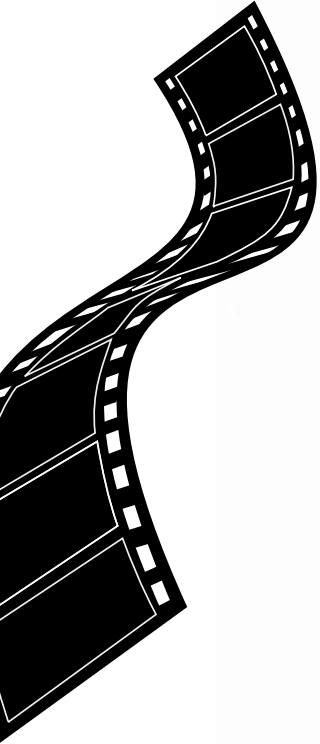

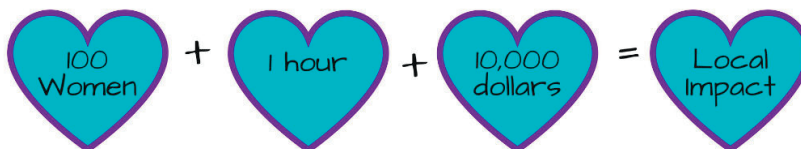
