FLAGSTAFF WASTE MANAGEMENT

Flagstaff Waste Management performs the garbage pick-up service in town, and manages the transfer site 3.7 km northwest of downtown Hardisty. Regular residential waste pickup occurs Monday mornings (Tuesday if Monday is a holiday). The transfer site is open both Wednesday and Saturday mornings from 8:30 a.m. until 12 p.m. (noon).

You are allowed a maximum of four (4) bags of garbage per week. Additional bag tags are available from the Town of Hardisty Office Monday-Friday 9 a.m.-4:30 p.m. at a cost of \$2 each.
