The Thrift Shop! Pop in and say hello today!




Did you know: We have a shop in town that donated \$38,000 to various charities in 2023? This month we would like to take the time to show appreciation to one of the most popular and vital shops in town — the Hardisty Thrift Shop! Located in the heart of downtown Hardisty, the Hardisty Thrift Shop has had a few locations in its lifetime, and has been in operation for over 41 years! This "business" is a 100% volunteer based service with an incredibly dedicated group of close to 40 individuals in a variety of roles. They keep this vital and dynamic service well organized, consistently delivering top notch displays. It takes many hours each week to sort through all of the incoming donations to create thoughtful displays and sections just like a regular department store. Photos and descriptions of newly donated product are then featured on their social media page a couple of times each week to lure us in. On each new week's beginning, with their Tuesday 1:30 pm opening, you will often find a line up of customers waiting for them to open this little shop; which has been a Godsend through some trying times in this economy. 




